

Compliance with the REACH Regulation

The REACH Regulation (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals), which came into force on December 18, 2006, governs the use of chemical substances in the European Union (EU) to protect human health and the environment.

This legislation applies to substances commonly used on a daily basis by manufacturers, importers, and professional users of chemicals, as well as by importers and manufacturers of articles containing such substances.

Digidelta's responsibility as a downstream user lies in its own production processes, ensuring that its suppliers comply with REACH, including the continuous monitoring of the registration of all substances in its products.

Our compliance with REACH legislation includes informing our customers about products containing substances of very high concern (SVHC), as listed on the SVHC Candidate List.

We notify the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and customers who have purchased or are purchasing a specific article whenever our suppliers declare the presence of these substances in their products at a mass concentration (w/w) equal to or greater than 0.1%.
